Dear ESU Alumni,

As everybody knows by heart already, (W)ESIB/ESU is celebrating 30th anniversary this year. In order to mark this achievement properly, we are organising a celebratory event and an Alumni meeting that will take place from **18th until 20th of October 2012 in Limassol, Cyprus**. On behalf of ESU and the host of the event – POFEN Cyprus – it is our pleasure to invite you to show us how ESU parties looked like in the past, to tell us what we are doing right and in general, to celebrate this organisation that has survived 30 years of student leadership and is now hopefully and finally entering maturity.

It is therefore crucial to keep alumni close to the organisation and to create opportunities for networking also between alumni. The Alumni Task Force is in charge of organising a meeting of alumni parallel to the Student Convention of ESU, while at parts all alumni will be invited to a common session to debate employability with the current ESU crowd. The alumni meeting aims to investigate potential for a better link between alumni and between alumni and ESU. You have gotten your dues from (W)ESIB/ESU, now ESU is calling upon you!

The event is open for all former student representatives that have been a part of ESU at some point (whether in the Board or as an elected representative) and want to celebrate this special occasion in style. Venue and accommodation

The accommodation for the event is arranged in the **Navarria hotel in Limassol, Cyprus**. We have already booked twin rooms for participants of both ESC 24 and Alumni meeting from 18th until 21st October. Please note that **arrival day should be the 18th and departure date the 21st of October**.

Participation fee

Participation fee for participants who have registered before 15th of September is 150 EUR. This fee includes accommodation (3 nights in twin room), food and evening activities (gala dinner etc.) Please note that the participation fee is fixed independent if you wish to stay for shorter period than 3 nights. In case you would like to arrange your own accommodation, you are free to do so, but please approach us at esc24@esu-online.org to find a solution.

This participation fee applies in case of registering on time. **Please note that registrations after 15th September will incur a 75 EUR extra fee per registration of a participant.**

Participation fee has to be paid in advance – the deadline for that is 10th of October. If you require an invoice in advance, please send an e-mail with your request to esc24@esu-online.org.
